ECTOFi Productions is working with the Great Falls Film Festival to be held in Great Falls, Montana on May 14th at the Mansfield Center.

Festival organizers still looking for more Montana made short films to showcase in the festival.

Two features to be shown at the Festival. Chronicles of MelEric: Attack of the Clones at 3:30, And "Piece By Piece," will have it's world premiere that evening at 7:30.

Great Falls, MT. April 14th, 2011: The Great Falls Film Festival is coming to the Mansfield Center in Great Falls. The event begins at 11:00am and events go into the night with a collection of short films and two feature length films made from around the state of Montana by Montana Filmmakers. The event Timeline is as follows.

11:00am to 3:30pm: Short films from around the state of Montana are being shown.

3:30pm to 5:00pm: Feature length Film "Chronicles of MelEric: Attack of the Clones."

5:00pm to 7:00pm: Dinner at MAT theater to meet the filmmakers and be entertained by Great Falls Toastmasters. Proceeds from this Dinner go to the MAT (Montana Actors Theater). (This event costs \$20.00 and is seperate from regular film festival costs. 60 person limit.)

7:00pm to 7:30pm: Red Carpet walk with stars of the Film.

7:30pm to 10:00pm: Premiere of "Piece By Piece." Starring Danny Lopez and Amber Koesling.

10:00pm to 12:00am: After party at MAT theater to meet and greet the filmmakers. Cost of entry is \$5.00 and is seperate from film festival costs. Open to any age but alcohol will be available for purchase. Proceeds from this event go to MAT.

The cost of an all day pass during the month of April is \$18.00. Single tickets for the Matinee cost \$9.00 and the evening show costs \$13.00. The prices will go up during the month of May. Individual tickets can be purchased online at <http://ticketing.greatfallsmt.net/>. An All-Day Pass must be purchased over the phone at (406) 455-8514.

Film Festival organizers still have an open registration for the film festival until May 1st, with the latest a film can be entered as May 7th. The extended entry time is to allow student films the opportunity to be entered if the students so choose. Short films that have been entered and have a place reserved in the festival already include:

“Piece by Piece,” a psychological horror film; directed by Eric Dunn, starring Danny Lopez, Amber Koesling, and Dave Malloy, was shot in Cascade County and is premiering on the evening of May 15th at a film festival in Great Falls at 7:30, organized in part by ECTOFi Productions.
